3. Applicants may self-nominate, or be nominated by a teacher or staff member
4. **IF SELF-NOMINATING:** Please attach an essay (500 words or less) on the following topic: Describe an act of kindness that was shown to you, or that you showed to someone else, during your high school years. How did this experience impact you? How do you think it affected the other person/persons involved?
5. **IF SELF-NOMINATING:** Please attach a brief description (250 words or less) of the school you will attend, what you plan to study, and your career aspirations.

6. **IF NOMINATED BY A TEACHER OR STAFF MEMBER:** Please attach an essay (500 words or less) on the following topic: Describe how the student has shown kindness and empathy on your school campus or in the community during his/her high school years. How has this student positively affected those around him/her? Also, please attach a brief description of the student's future educational plans and career goals.
